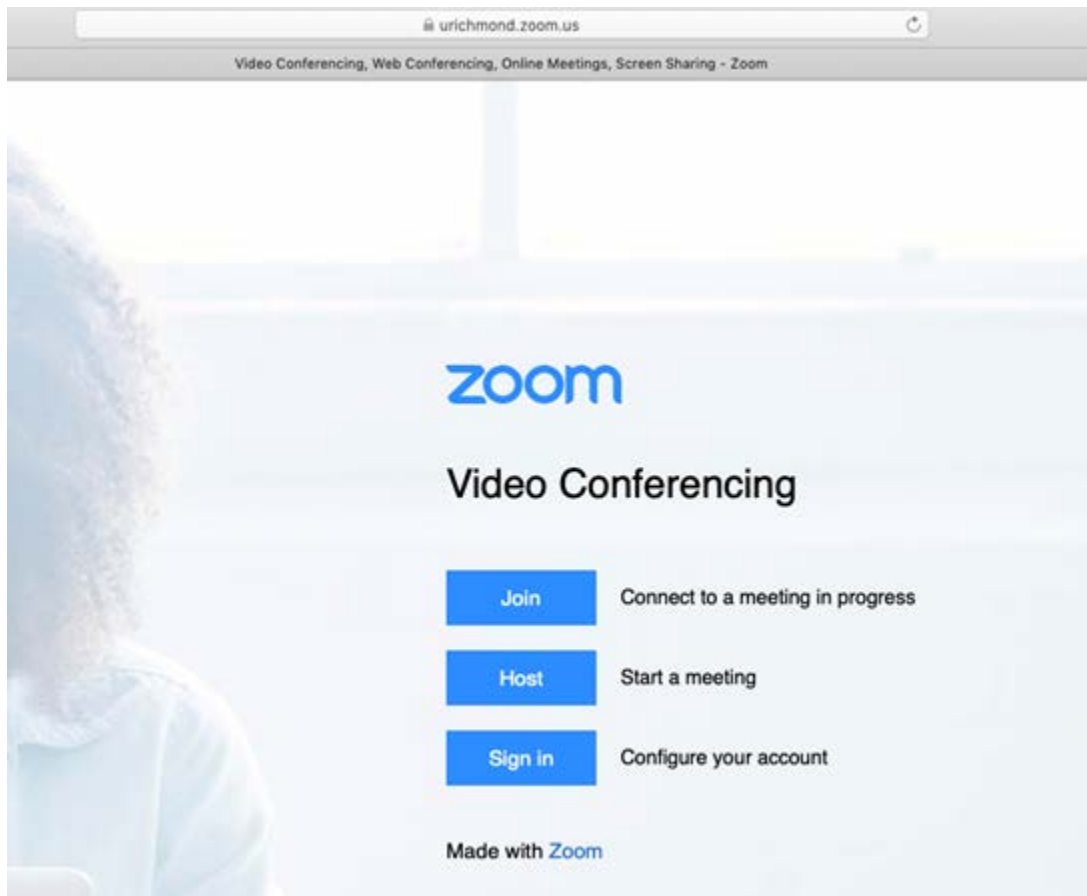


What is Zoom?

Zoom is video conferencing software that you can use to have one on one phone calls, small meetings, or hold interactive class meetings. Zoom is the best tool for synchronous class meetings, as opposed to Panopto, which is used to record videos for students to view asynchronously. The university has provided all instructors with a pro-level Zoom account.

How do I use Zoom?

To get started, visit urichmond.zoom.us. Click “sign in” to configure your account:
