

Application Instructions

This material is to be used by applicants for the LL.M. for international lawyers enrolling in 2019.

Notes and Instructions:

- --Requirements include a first degree in law from outside the U.S.; TOEFL or IELTS exam scores (or a waiver).
- --An application processing fee of \$50 (U.S.) should accompany each application. If payment of this fee will prevent a student from applying, waiver requests should be submitted to lawadmissions@richmond.edu. The fee is not refundable and may not be applied to any other university fee.
- --An applicant is not required to register for LSAC's LLM Credential Service (LLM CAS) although an applicant may choose to use this service. The LLM CAS Service includes authentication and evaluation of official transcripts from all institutions of higher education attended, as well as all other documents submitted to LSAC for distribution to all law schools to which you are applying.
- --Alternatively, an applicant may submit an application directly to the law school (law.richmond.edu) along with official, certified copies of transcripts, translated into English, from all institutions of higher education attended. A transcript evaluation, if available, may also be submitted but is not required.
- --Two letters of recommendation from professors or colleagues familiar with your academic and/or legal qualifications are required. Applicants may use the Letter of Recommendation Service offered through LSAC. If you choose to use this service, the letter from each recommender must be sent directly to LSAC along with the Letter of Recommendation Form, which is available via LSAC.org. If you are not using this service letters should be sent directly from the recommender to lawadmissions@richmond.edu.
- --A short narrative (personal) statement (approximately 500 words) is required as part of the application process. We encourage you to give us some insight into your career goals and experiences which may have factored into your decision to pursue this advanced degree as well as a narrative to help us know more about you aside from the information contained in your application.
- --Your resume should include detailed information, with dates, about your academic and professional experience.
- --Providing Information about age, race, and gender is optional but is needed by the school for statistical purposes. The school believes that an applicant's race or ethnic group is a factor that legitimately can be considered during the admissions process to promote the representation of minorities in the Law School and the legal profession. Neither gender, age, nor race will be used in an unlawfully discriminatory manner. You are ensured both by school policy and by the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act that any information you provide will be confidential and accessible only to school officials, government agencies, and others with legitimate educational interest in this information.
